It is essential to select the right legal professional when trying to resolve your legal matter and obtain advice. It is important for you to know and understand your legal professional's credentials and background, in order to determine who you should choose to represent you.

Lawyers maintain an extensive level of professional qualifications and education that allow them to undertake cases in a wide variety of areas. All lawyers must have a Juris Doctorate degree or the equivalent, as well as successfully complete the Law Society of Ontario's licensing process requirements which also include the Barrister and Solicitor examinations.

Lawyers must also successfully complete a 10-month Articling Program in which candidates remain supervised under a principal lawyer who provides them with necessary training while they learn what the practice of law entails.



Ultimately, lawyers in Ontario have a license to provide legal services under a wide variety of areas such as civil litigation, business law, wills and estates, real estate, criminal, and other types of law.

There are some areas that are more specialized than others, and require choosing a lawyer that best suits your matter and can provide you with the expertise needed for your case. Licensed lawyers may appear and represent clients in all levels of the court system in Ontario, and can assist you with your matter in a wide variety of areas.

It is important to understand and know your lawyer's credentials and experience, when choosing the right individual to represent you.

Paralegals are also regulated by the Law Society of Ontario and are limited in their scope of practice. Paralegals obtain their paralegal license by successfully completing the Paralegal Licensing Process which includes the Licensing Examinations. Paralegals can only take on cases at the Small Claims Court level which has jurisdiction over monetary claims up to a maximum of \$35,000.

Paralegals are also allowed to assist in cases involving the Highway Traffic Act and appear in front of tribunals such as the Landlord and Tenant Board or the Workplace Safety and Insurance Board. They are also able to represent you with certain summary conviction criminal charges under a Criminal Code proceeding in the Ontario Court of Justice. With these types of matters, it may be appropriate to obtain the services of a paralegal.



It is essential that you retain legal services from someone who is licensed by the Law Society of Ontario. There are some exemptions for people who are excluded from the regulations of the Law Society of Ontario, for example immigration consultants.

Immigration consultants are regulated by the Immigration Consultants of Canada Regulatory Council (ICCRC). Immigration consultants are designated as Regulated Canadian Immigration Consultants (RCICs) and are required to have knowledge about Canadian immigration and refugee law, must meet a language test standard in either English or French, complete a post secondary accredited program, and pass the ICCRC exam. There are also Regulated International Student Immigration Advisors (RISIAs), which are also regulated by the ICCRC.

The role of immigration consultants is to assess client information and to determine the likelihood of approval for their designated visa. Additionally, immigration consultants assist clients and prepare them for their visa interviews along with helping them with their applications and submission. On the other hand, immigration lawyers can represent you during an immigration interview, and can advocate for your application if you need to be represented in various levels of court and if your case reaches judicial review.

It is important to be mindful of these differences the next time you decide to seek legal representation, in order to ensure which legal professional is right for you and your legal matter. It is essential to understand their area of expertise, their credentials, and background, to confirm you are making the right decision for your matter.

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Parenting Issues During Separation And Divorce



If you are going through a separation or divorce, you and your spouse need to reach an agreement in relation to parenting issues or a judge will make an Order in relation to parenting issues which includes parenting decision making and parenting time.

Parenting Decision Making

One of the most contentious issues that arises during a separation or divorce is child related decisions, including:

- ▶ Where will the child live?
- ▶ How much time will each parent spend with the child?
- ▶ How will parents make major decisions about how to care for and raise the child?



Decision making responsibility is the right to make major decisions about how to care for and raise your child. Decision making responsibility was formerly referred to as 'custody'.

The parent with decision making responsibility has the right to make important decisions about:

- ▶ The child's education
- ▶ The child's medical care
- ▶ The child's religion
- ▶ The child's welfare

Decision making responsibility can be divided in a number of ways, including:

- ▶ One parent has sole the decision making responsibility, and may or may not need to consult the other parent prior to making any major decisions;
- ▶ Both parents have decision making responsibility, although one parent may or may not have say regarding major decisions that affect the child(ren); or
- ▶ Each parent is responsible for different areas. For example, one parent makes decisions about the child's health and another parent makes decisions about the child's education.

Parenting Time

The time that a child spends in the care of a parent is called parenting time. Parenting time was formally referred to as 'access'. When a child lives with one parent, the non custodial parent has the right to spend time with the child considering the child's best interests.

There are various types of parenting arrangements, depending on the child's needs and best interest. It is advisable to contact a family lawyer to learn more about your parenting rights and obligation.

What is a Will?

A legal document that declares your wishes regarding the distribution of your movable and immovable property and how you will care for your child or young or disabled children after death. In Canada, there are no restrictions on the estate percentage you will distribute to your beneficiaries, as well as the appointment of a guardian and guardian for children under 18 years of age. Therefore, this is a legal advantage to maximize your will, and for this purpose, it is recommended to prepare a formal will in accordance with legal standards.



In Canada, it is strongly recommended that each adult with a child or property must have a formal will.

You can set up your first will or revoke the previous ones with signing a new one whenever you are mentally healthy.

The will must be written and signed in the presence of a solicitor or notary and at least one more witness, and it is recommended that if you change your state of residence, consult with a solicitor to ensure that your will complies with the provincial law, and if applicable revise it as soon as possible.

If you die without a will, the law calls you a "deceased without a will" or "Intestate", which means that you have left no instructions on how to divide and distribute your assets, and your assets will be divided among your survivors or survivors according to provincial law.

In this case, the provincial law sets out how your assets should be divided.

Benefits of having a formal will:

By having a valid will, you can voluntarily decide how to distribute your property and assets after death and do not leave it to the law, because it may not be in accordance with your wishes and aspirations.

By making a legal will, possible family disputes after death are minimized and your property is divided between the people you love.

One of the most important benefits of having a will is to determine how to care for and select the guardian of your child or children under 18 years of age. If you do not have a will, the court will appoint a guardian at their discretion. It was not what you wanted. Having a will gives you the freedom to choose the person you want to take care of your child after you.

According to the will, you can donate your property and enjoy the benefits of tax exemption. A will can also be an important part of your financial planning and reduce the burden of paying your taxes when donating property.



■ The process of monopolizing the inheritance is done faster with a will and at a much lower cost, and the court does not comment and decide on how to divide the inheritance between the heirs, and you avoid the heavy costs of appointing a property manager.



■ By having a will, you choose a trusted and accepted person to manage your property, which puts the best interests of your family first.

■ The will in its entirety allows you to determine how to distribute.

■ Remember that you can change your will, in whole or in part, at any time, depending on the circumstances of your life.



What is Cerebral Palsy?

The human brain is a marvel of complexity, consisting of 100 billion neurons, and each of them is connected to 10,000 others. The human brain has been described as the most complicated object in the known universe.



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Scientists have learned that plasticity within the brain gives it the ability to create new neuropathways. When there is a disruption to parts of the existing brain structure, abnormal brain development or an adverse event, it may cause severe brain damage and permanent disability.

When these brain abnormalities or traumas occur to a developing brain during pregnancy, birth or in the first two to three years of a child's life, they can lead to cerebral palsy (CP) – the most common motor disability in children.

One out of every four hundred Canadians is diagnosed with the condition, and many people have limited knowledge about cerebral palsy. If you are a new parent who has just learned that your child will receive a CP diagnosis, you will likely want to learn all you can about how this brain damage occurred and what you can do to help your child manage this condition. In this blog, I outline the four types of Cerebral Palsy, describe common symptoms, list the most frequent causes of this disorder, and explain how you may be entitled to monetary damages if a medical professional's negligence caused or contributed to this brain damage.

A person experiencing spastic CP can have a diagnosis that further specifies which body parts are affected.

Dyskinetic Cerebral Palsy: This type of CP makes it difficult for a person to control the movements of their limbs and can lead to uncontrollable movement.

Changes in muscle tone from tightness to looseness may occur frequently – even over a single day.



Ataxic Cerebral Palsy: People with ataxic CP have difficulty with balance, coordination, and unsteadiness.

Complex motor actions that require a high degree of muscle control may be challenging.

What are the types of Cerebral Palsy?

Each person experiences cerebral palsy differently and may have a unique combination of symptoms. However, when CP is diagnosed, it is classified as one of four types:

Spastic Cerebral Palsy: The most common form of CP causes increased muscle tone that results in stiff muscles and awkward movement.

Mixed Cerebral Palsy: The CP diagnosis is made when a person has more than one of the three types of CP noted above.



What are the symptoms of Cerebral Palsy?

Although every person will experience CP differently, some common symptoms include:

- Rigid or loose muscle tone
- Lack of balance, coordination, or other difficulty walking (awkward gait)
- Tremors, involuntary movements, or seizures
- Slow or writhing motions
- Favouring one side of the body
- Difficulty eating, sucking or swallowing and excessive drooling
- Motor skill or speech milestone delays
- Fine motor skill challenges
- Learning disabilities
- Other neurological issues, such as difficulty seeing or hearing, intellectual disabilities, abnormal touch or pain sensations, oral health diseases, and mental health conditions

What are the causes of Cerebral Palsy?

The cause of cerebral palsy is often unknown. However, factors that can lead to problems with brain development include:

- Fetal stroke
- Lack of oxygen to the brain related to a difficult birth
- Gene mutations leading to abnormal development
- Maternal infections affecting the developing fetus
- Infant infections causing inflammation in or around the brain
- Traumatic head injury to an infant post birth
- Untreated infant jaundice



In addition, certain risk factors in pregnancy or birth increase the chance of CP. These include delivery in the breech position (feet first), multiple births, low birth weight, and premature birth.



What Can Be Done If Your Child Has Cerebral Palsy?

Although there is no cure for CP, early interventions, medication, and physical therapies can lead to better outcomes as your child develops and can improve their quality of life. Muscle relaxants or injections may improve functional abilities, reduce pain and/or manage complications.

Physical therapy, occupational therapy, speech and language therapy and recreational therapy can improve motor skill development, adapt to their abilities, and help children gain independence.

These therapies, assistive aids and, in more serious cases, ongoing medical and attendant care can be costly. Although private insurance and public health care services cover some of these treatments and interventions, parents and caregivers of people with CP may still be required to pay out of pocket for some of these medical needs. Furthermore, a person with significant and severe disabilities caused by CP may not live independently or provide for themselves in adulthood.

While the factors causing CP are sometimes natural or unavoidable, in other cases, proper medical care could have prevented brain abnormalities associated with CP. From regular check ups and monitoring by doctors during pregnancy to choices made and actions taken (or not taken) during difficult births or in infancy, medical professionals can significantly reduce the likelihood that a problem during or after pregnancy could lead to CP.

Do you believe medical negligence caused or contributed to your child's CP? Are you unsure as to its cause? Do you think an investigation may give you answers? Contact a birth injury lawyer to examine your case and medical files.

While establishing medical negligence causing harm can be difficult, an award or settlement for damages could significantly assist you and your child as you manage life with a CP diagnosis.
